- Music-singing words that are difficult to understand or remember through songs and poems. In this, in addition to remembering new words, the child's oral speech also develops. An example of this is the fact that children learn the alphabet of English by singing, which is more effective than just memorizing.

- TO includes most of the games to help master competitive grammar and vocabulary. In this, the children perform various tasks that the teacher has given them. As a result, competition among students is created, which further increases their interest in language learning. After all, as Chinese thinkers say: “all human interests arise through competition.”

- Mixed technique here we can optionally combine different techniques. For example, in this, children can play games, sing songs, draw, show new words through various actions. The advantage of the technique is in Variety. In this, the reader is not limited to just one thing.

- * Teaching through cartoons. As you know, children are interested in watching various cartoons. And in the process of viewing cartoons in English, although it does not understand the statements in the cartoon, it seeks to understand the words they are

using through the actions of the cartoon characters. This is an interesting and effective way for children to learn a language.
