E-mail, electronic libraries - sites provide unlimited opportunities for the educational system, eliminate any borders, make it possible to receive educational and scientific information from anywhere in the world.

The emergence of multimedia systems has led to drastic changes in many areas of human activity. One of the widely used fields of multimedia technologies is education, because multimedia-based information tools have the ability to increase the effectiveness of education.

Multimedia is: a technology that describes the procedure for developing and using various forms of information processing tools; information resources created

on the basis of various types of information processing and presentation technologies; computer software related to the processing and presentation of information in various forms; computer hardware support that allows working with information in various forms; a special generalized view of information that includes traditional static visual (text, graphics) and dynamic information in various forms (speech, music, videos, animation, etc.).

The term "multimedia" in a broad sense refers to the range of information technologies that use various software and technical tools to effectively influence the user (who is simultaneously a speaker, listener, and viewer).

Multimedia technologies allow to consciously and harmoniously combine many forms of information and, in turn, to present information with the help of a computer in the following forms: images, scanned images, drawings, slides; sound recordings, sound effects and music: video, complex video effects: animations and animated views. Multimedia can be used in the context of different forms of learning and understood by different people, that is, some people prefer to read, others prefer to learn by listening and watching videos.

The use of multimedia allowed students to work with educational materials in different ways. That is, the learner decides for himself how to learn the educational material, how to use the interactive capabilities of electronic educational tools, and how to work in cooperation with other students, who are part of the educational process. become active participants. There are grounds for didactic implementation of the demonstration principle of teaching.

On the one hand, the implementation process through an animated model on a computer and showing it to students saves time spent on conducting fundamental experiments and similar processes in lecture sessions, and on the other hand, it saves time spent on the objects. creates useful opportunities to directly see, monitor, reflect, and exchange ideas.

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
